
WANDERFESTIVAL KLEINWALSERTAL - HIKE THE

TOUR DESCRIPTION

The Gold Trail of "Hike the Valley" is approximately 23 kilometers long and has an elevation gain of about 1,000 meters.

For all ambitious and experienced hikers, this route is a personal challenge in the midst of the beautiful nature of the Kleinwalsertal v surpass themselves on this technically and physically demanding route and be proud of having conquered the royal route when they aimed at experienced hikers. It leads over partially exposed sections and requires a head for heights and sure-footedness.

After starting at the Walserhaus in Hirschegg, the route leads via Rohrweg and Schöntalweg up to the Heubergbahn mountain station Ochsenhofer Köpfe and down into the Schwarzwassertal valley. The route leads through the Hirschegg district of Wäldele to the finish
